**Suggested Itineraries**

- Up to 2 hours**  
 Tour the State Rooms, the Churchill Exhibition, and "Blenheim Palace: The Untold Story". Take a short walk to the majestic Water Terraces and the Italian Garden.
- Up to 4 hours**  
 Tour the Palace as above then visit the Formal Gardens further afield including the Secret Garden, the Rose Garden leading on to the Blenheim Dam and Cascade.
- Over 4 hours**  
 Tour the Palace, visit the Indoor Cinema and the "Churchill's Destiny" Exhibition. Stop for lunch in the Water Terraces Café then explore the Formal Gardens. Catch the Miniature Train to the Pleasure Gardens to enjoy the Marlborough Maze, Butterfly House, Adventure Play Area and 'Blenheim Bygones' Exhibition.

**Park & Garden Walks**

**The Lake & Cascade**

A circular walk of 1 mile or 45 minutes over difficult terrain. Follow the signs for the Rose Garden, the Cascade and Pump House. Continue to the right of the Pump House and follow the path. Please note there is a steep slope from the Water Terraces to the Boathouse.

*The recently restored Dam and Cascade has a new walkway and viewing area which is accessible to wheelchair users. It is recommended that wheelchair users should pass the Boathouse on their outward journey.*

**Queen Pool**

A circular walk around the lake of 1.5 miles or up to 45 minutes, takes in the Grand Bridge, a view of Rosamund's Well and the Lake, following the road up a very steep hill to the Triumphal Arch at Woodstock Gate.

*Accessible for wheelchair users, please ask at Flagstaff Information Point.*

**The Duke's Gardens**

A circular walk around the lake of 1.5 miles or up to 1 hour. From the Water Terraces follow the signs towards the Rose Garden along the South Lawn. Cross the South Lawn towards the Secret Garden where you can enjoy a seat. Return via the Italian Garden to the Water Terraces.

*Accessible for wheelchair users.*
