Vocabulary (shapes, colours, texture) and numeracy will be the focus.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Archives</p> <p>KS2 Pupils will be introduced to the world of archives as they explore archival material. Activities will include examining century-old formal letters (structure and content), exploring measurements systems (imperial vs metric) and British currency (old money vs decimal system), map-reading (old map vs O.S. map), and introduction to archival environment.</p> | <p style="text-align: center;">Walled Garden Intro Science Walk</p> <p>EYFS Pupils will hear stories about trees, butterflies, bees, flowers, vegetables and fruit as they walk from the Butterfly House to the Kitchen Garden. Vocabulary (living things and non-living things) and numeracy will be the focus.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Kitchen Garden</p> <p>KS2 Pupils will explore the world of living things (lifecycle of plants, butterflies and bees). Choice of activities: Designing/Colouring a castle of a palace; Designing Coat of Arms; or Making a Crown or Coronet. KS2 Pupils will learn about British monarchy and aristocracy. The focus will be the Victorian era and the Family's royal connections.
