Britain’s Greatest Palace

Showcasing grandeur on the largest of scales, Blenheim Palace is the only non-royal residence in England to hold the title of Palace. It was gifted by Queen Anne and a grateful nation to the 1st Duke of Marlborough, following his victory at the Battle of Blenheim in 1704. Palace architect Sir John Vanbrugh’s magnificent English Baroque architecture reflects not only the 1st Duke’s military achievements, but also Vanbrugh’s feeling that the Palace should, at the same time, be a monument to Queen Anne’s glory. Blenheim Palace remains the seat of the Dukes of Marlborough and is also the birthplace of Sir Winston Churchill.

Then there is the Palace’s idyllic setting – the Palace is surrounded by 2000 acres of pastoral, man-made Parkland, designed by master landscaper Lancelot ‘Capability’ Brown, as well as its beautiful Gardens. The sweeping view of the Palace, Grand Bridge and Queen Pool lake were once described by Lord Randolph Churchill (the father of Sir Winston Churchill) as ‘the finest view in England’, and it continues to awe our visitors today. The Blenheim Palace Gardens span centuries in their creation and landscape style, from when the Palace was first built to the early 1900s.

Spectacular Settings to Discover

■ The Palace State Rooms

Explore the opulent Palace State Rooms, filled with priceless collections of tapestries, paintings and furniture. Each item has its own story to be told, and each room its own unique aesthetic and purpose. The route is fully accessible for wheelchairs and our team of knowledgeable Guides are always ready and waiting to share 300 years of Palace stories.

■ The Gardens

Spanning approximately 160 acres, the Blenheim Palace Gardens are a treat for the senses in all seasons. From the 300 year old Walled Garden which was built alongside the Palace to the baroque-style grandeur of the Water Terraces, Italian Garden and Rose Garden, there are endless views, blooms and pathways to discover. Step into the temple where Sir Winston Churchill proposed to his then fiancé, and onto the Cascades bridge to get up close to ‘Capability’ Brown’s impressive man-made waterfall.

■ The Parkland and Estate

The Parkland extends 2000 acres around the Palace, and was transformed into an idyllic, naturalised English landscape by ‘Capability’ Brown in the 1700s. This included the creation of the Great Lake and planting thousands of mature trees. Our vast Estate is a rich haven of flora and fauna with no shortage of natural beauty to discover. It is also home to a diverse range of wildlife including deer, otters, water voles and bats as well as birds such as red kites, herons and owls. There is even a Blenheim species of honeybee. With the largest collection of ancient oak trees in Europe, and one of the most biodiverse spaces in the country, the Estate is recognised as a Site of Specific Scientific Interest (SSSI). The High Park woodland dates back to the medieval period and was once the hunting ground of King Henry I, with ancient oaks over 900 years old.

Out of hours

We have a wide range of private tours available that take place outside of our standard opening hours, so your clients can have more of the Palace, Gardens or Estate to themselves and discover their wonders in the quieter early morning or evening periods, led by one of our expert team members.

■ Palace Guided Tour

■ Private Apartments Tour

Explore the Palace's Private Apartments which have hosted many Dukes, Duchesses and opulent guests, as well as the downstairs kitchens and household quarters that are still used by the butler today.

Your clients will be led through the story of the Palace Gardens and the key characters that have contributed throughout its 300-year history including the 1st Duke of Marlborough for whom they were built, Sir Winston Churchill who proposed here and the landscaping visionaries who shaped the gardens into what we can see today - namely, Henry Wise, Lancelot 'Capability' Brown and Achille Duchene.

Blenheim Palace is ready for its close up.

Opening in 2027, Beyond the Silver Screen is a bold, immersive exhibition celebrating nearly a century of cinematic history filmed within one of the world's most recognisable palaces. Developed in collaboration with some of the world's leading film studios and global streaming production companies, this exhibition reveals Blenheim as you have never seen it before, not just a UNESCO World Heritage Site, but a leading actor on the global stage.

From sweeping costume dramas and royal romances to spy thrillers, science fiction spectacles and family favourites, Blenheim has played many roles. Battlefields and ballrooms. Royal courts and futuristic worlds. Again and again, storytellers return because Blenheim does not just host history, it performs it.



Our Experiences



■ Reel Back the Years

The story begins where cinema itself was still finding its feet.

Drawing on extensive archival research and material generously shared by international production partners, the exhibition rewinds to the early days of filmmaking, uncovering extraordinary connections to British screen history. A standout moment is the haunting post war epic *Saraband for Dead Lovers*, filmed at Blenheim in the 1940s. Thanks to the support of StudioCanal, rare archival images lift the curtain on this pivotal production, capturing the Palace at the moment heritage met Hollywood.

Each frame is a time capsule. Each discovery is a reminder that the cameras have been rolling here for generations.

■ Cue the Blockbusters

Fast forward and Blenheim is still stealing the scene.

In recent years, the Palace has dazzled global audiences through collaborations with major international studios and streaming platforms, appearing in productions such as Ridley Scott's *Napoleon* and *Shondaland's* worldwide phenomenon *Bridgerton*, alongside beloved titles including *The Young Victoria*, *The BFG* and *Gulliver's Travels*. From powdered wigs to power plays, candlelight to CGI, Blenheim continues to adapt, commanding every genre it takes on.

With more than 70 film and television productions shot across the Palace and grounds, *Beyond the Silver Screen* celebrates a filmography as rich and varied as the stories it tells.

Some titles you will recognise instantly. Others remain under wraps. After all, every great production keeps a few secrets behind the scenes.



■ Step Inside the World of Filmmaking

This is not a watch from the wings exhibition. Created in close collaboration with filmmakers, designers and production teams, visitors are invited to step onto the set and into the hidden world of filming. They will encounter iconic props and costumes, evocative set pieces, rare archival material and revealing behind the camera stories that show how Blenheim transforms from historic palace to global screen star.

Highlights include *Cinderella's* iconic glass slipper and unforgettable ball gown, shown alongside contemporary props and production elements from *Citadel 2*. From fairytale fantasy to high tension espionage, these objects sit side by side to demonstrate the extraordinary range of Blenheim's screen life.

A programme of speakers and special events will also reveal what happens when a historic palace becomes an active filming location, offering insider insight from industry professionals working at scale. This is a backstage pass into the art of illusion where heritage, creativity and technology collide.

■ From Screen to Scene

Developed with the support of VisitBritain and aligned with the Starring GREAT Britain campaign, *Beyond the Silver Screen* celebrates the powerful connection between film, place and travel. Cinema does not just entertain, it inspires audiences to cross continents, follow familiar footsteps and experience locations made famous on screen.



At Blenheim, visitors do not just watch the story unfold – they walk straight into it.



Regenerative tourism at Blenheim Palace
