Our Educational Programme

Our educational programme for international students includes a range of options to best suit your students' needs. We offer a 45-minute tour of the Palace, on which our knowledgeable and experienced Guides use storytelling techniques and illustrated resources to support vocabulary development and contextual understanding. This can be followed by a 45-minute interactive workshop session led by a member of our Education Team and again tailored specifically for EFL students.

Our tours and workshop sessions explore a wide range of topics including the British and European royal families, pivotal historical events, and the enduring legacy of Sir Winston Churchill, enabling students to place their learning within a broader cultural and historical context. Our standard workshop capacity is up to 15 students, but for larger groups we divide students into smaller rotations to ensure an engaging, high-quality experience for everyone. We also offer a variety of self-led resources that can be used by the visit leader and students to introduce and consolidate learning both before and after your visit.

Taking learning outdoors

Our 2,000 acre Estate provides an exceptional setting for outdoor learning. From our Parkland and the Great Lake designed by "Capability" Brown in the 18th century to the beautiful Formal Gardens and working Kitchen Garden, there's plenty to explore. Students can engage with nature, discover the history of our Gardens and spot native British wildlife. Down in the Walled Garden we also have our Marlborough Maze, perfect for team challenges, our Rowse Honey Hive where students can learn about the importance of our native wildflowers and pollinators and our Butterfly House which is home to butterfly species from all over the world.

Blenheim Palace offers a truly immersive environment in which students can practise English with purpose and confidence. Through conversations with knowledgeable guides, exploration of authentic historic surroundings, and participation in engaging, hands-on activities, learners naturally build fluency and self-assurance. Blandford Academy Workshops



English Language & British History

English Vocabulary Tour

This is a 45 minute guided tour through the Palace State Rooms offered with the English Language & British History Workshop. Whilst visiting the home of the Duke of Marlborough and exploring the history of the Palace, there will be a focus on English vocabulary. This will include opportunities to learn English words and British expressions.

Winston Churchill at Blenheim Palace & WWII in Britain

This is a 45 minute workshop led by a member of the Blenheim Palace Education Team in the M15 Room. Learning will be based on the subject of Sir Winston Churchill at Blenheim Palace and WWII on the home front.

Students will explore:

- Churchill's interests and jobs
- Churchill's link with Blenheim Palace
- Churchill's War speeches
- Britain on the Home Front during WWII and its major events



Winston Churchill & WWII at Blenheim Palace Tour

This is a 45 minute guided tour through the Palace State Rooms offered with the Winston Churchill at Blenheim Palace & WWII in Britain Workshop. Whilst visiting the home of the Duke of Marlborough and exploring the history of the Palace, there will be a focus on the connections between Winston Churchill, the Spencer-Churchill family and WWII at Blenheim Palace.

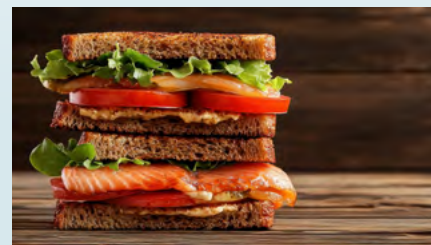
